Good morning, everyone!

What a beautiful day this is! Looking out at all of you—our 2,760 graduates—I can't help but feel incredibly proud. You've worked so hard to get here, and today isn't just about finishing your studies. It's about becoming the skilled professionals our country needs. When I think about what we've accomplished together, I'm amazed. Over the past few years, we've been busy building something special here at Sigalagala National Polytechnic.

We created our Strategic Plan for 2024–2028—think of it as our roadmap for helping students like you succeed. We've also put together 23 new policies that make everything run smoother, from how we train to how we support you as students. And you know what? We're not stopping there. We're going to finish the remaining policies this year because we believe you deserve the best possible education. I'll be honest—we used to do a lot of paperwork by hand, and it was slow and sometimes messy.

But we've changed all that! Now everything is digital—from paying bills to tracking student progress. We trained 10 of our staff members to use these new systems, and the difference is incredible. Things get done faster, with fewer mistakes, and we can see exactly how we're doing in real-time. You might have noticed that big new building going

up—our 72-training block. I'm excited to tell you it's almost ready! This building will house over 2,000 students at a time. Sometimes we have to make tough choices, but we never gave up on this dream. But we're dreaming even bigger. We want workshops that look like real factories, laboratories with the latest equipment, and comfortable hostels where students can live safely on campus. We want to prepare you not just for jobs, but for the careers of tomorrow.

Our staff has grown from 334 people in 2023 to 398 today. Each new person we hire means smaller classes and more attention for each student. We're even working on using artificial intelligence to help our teachers become even better at what they do. We couldn't do this alone. The Ministry of Education guides us and makes sure we're on the right track. Our friends at GIZ help us create real-world training programs so when you graduate, you're ready to work from day one. Local and national governments help us reach students from all corners of Kenya.

Let me be honest with you—we still have work to do. Some of our equipment is getting old, and we know it. We need more hostel rooms because many of you come from far away, and finding safe, affordable housing off-campus is tough. We're working on getting more trainers too, because every trainee deserves personal attention. So here's what I'm asking our leaders—from Parliament to local governments: Help us help Kenya's young people. Help us get modern equipment, build safe housing, hire great teachers, and create secure campuses. When you invest in places like Sigalagala, you're investing in Kenya's future.

And to you, our amazing graduates—you've made it! You've worked hard, overcome challenges, and now you're ready to make a difference. Whether you start your own business, join a company, or continue studying, remember that you carry the skills and values we've shared with you. Your families are proud. Your teachers are proud. And I am incredibly proud. Congratulations, Class of 2025! Go out there and show the world what you can do!

MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF PRINCIPAL

Today marks the moment when training is transformed into achievement, perseverance is rewarded, and 2,760 graduands take their first confident step into national relevance. This is not the end of your story, but the unveiling of your mission that is built on your skill, driven by ambition, and embraced by a nation expectant of your contribution.

Over the past five years, our enrolment has grown from 7,000 trainees in 2020 to 18,797 in 2025, a powerful testament to public confidence and the rising demand for Competency Based skilling. These numbers reflect a stronger youth workforce for both local economies, national and international industry. We envision surpassing 20,000 trainees, expanding STEM innovation hubs, strengthening enterprise centers, and increasing the participation of young women in high growth technology trades.

In fulfillment of the Government's directive on modularization of CBET curricula, over 50 modular curricula have been developed, approved by TVETA and KNQA, and are now fully implemented at Sigalagala National Polytechnic. This has enhanced industry alignment and employability.

During the Young Africa Works in Kenya – TVET Program Partners Close Out Forum held on 31st July 2025 at Pride Inn Paradise Hotel, Mombasa, Sigalagala National Polytechnic was honoured as the overall Best TVET Institution nationally in CBET implementation, and ranked second best in Industry Linkages. This recognition affirms our leadership in advancing modularized CBET and our strong partnerships with industry that continue to shape a skilled, work ready workforce for Kenya and beyond.

Six departments have operationalized RPL, with over 40 skill areas now being assessed. This initiative empowers artisans and technicians with formal certification, strengthening communities and local economies.

In December 2025, RPL assessments will extend further, with 37 inmates from the Government of Kenya Kakamega Prisons and 157 candidates from Okame TVC in Busia County, scheduled to be assessed, affirming our commitment to inclusive skilling and national transformation. Through our partnership with GIZ, five academic departments have rolled out Dual Training models that immerse trainees in industry, fortifying workplace readiness.

To align with Kenya's Vision 2030, Sigalagala National Polytechnic has boldly advanced digital transformation. The Jitume Youth Digitalisation Initiative has equipped hundreds of young people with market responsive digital skills, enabling online income generation and expanding access to digital tools. In addition, through sponsorship by Information Systems Audit and Control Association (ISACA), our trainees have undergone specialized training in digital trust, cybersecurity, and IT governance, further strengthening their readiness for the modern workplace.

The institution has also launched an AI Upskilling Programme for staff, enhancing classroom delivery and transforming institutional efficiency across departments.

Our trainees and staff continue to shine in national innovation arenas, excelling in robotics, skills, and research competitions. Two sets of our trainees champions in Beauty Therapy and Wellness, and Electrical and Electronics skills will represent Kenya at the 2026 World Skills Competition in Ethiopia. Beyond technical mastery, our trainees have triumphed in sports, drama, and music. In 2025, Sigalagala was crowned Best TVET Institution at the Kenya National Music Festivals, while our Football Titans proudly compete in the National Division 1 League, Zone D. We also celebrate our trainees' victory in the Regional Lacrosse Competition, a testament to their versatility, excellence, competitive spirit, and the only TVET institution that participated in that competition. These victories reflect discipline, dedication, nurture, and institutional strategy.

Guided by the Presidential call on environmental stewardship, Sigalagala National Polytechnic stands as a fortress of green action and climate responsibility. We have championed tree growing campaigns across the region and communities, embedding green competencies into every CBET programme to ensure that sustainability is not just taught, but lived. In partnership with Kenya Forestry Research Institute (KEFRI), we are advancing seedling production, forest research collaboration, and community conservation training, while mobilizing schools and institutions to embrace environmental responsibility. Over 300 staff members have already been trained in environmental greening, building institutional capacity for long term impact. Looking ahead, we are preparing to establish a KEFRI-SNP Demonstration Forest, which will serve as a living laboratory for research, training, and community engagement. This initiative will not only expand Kenya's forest cover but also nurture a generation of environmentally conscious graduates who carry sustainability as a core professional value. Through these deliberate actions, Sigalagala affirms its role in supporting Kenya's Vision 2030 and global climate goals, ensuring that technical education contributes directly to ecological resilience, green innovation, and sustainable livelihoods.

Yet, despite these successes, challenges remain. We face limited student accommodation and the urgent need to modernize workshops and laboratories. We respectfully appeal to the Government and partners to address this capacity gap. Rising electricity costs also strain our resources, and we therefore call for Sigalagala's prioritization in the national TVET Solar KCB Project to ensure sustainable energy for training.

To our graduands, step boldly into your future. Carry with you the skills, resilience, and values nurtured here. May your mission be a light to your communities, our nation, and the world.
